November 13, 2021



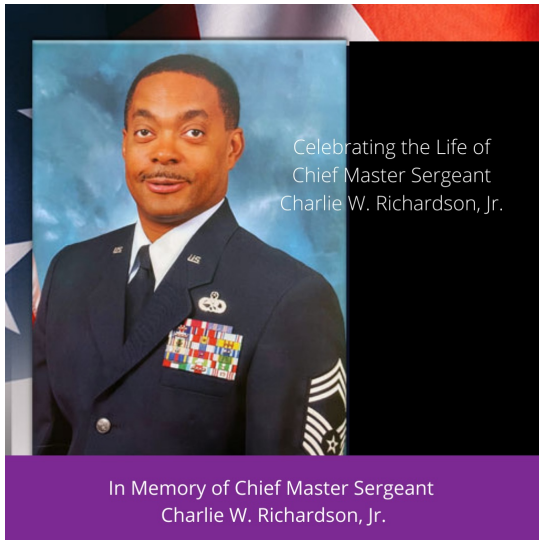
